




# Procedure for Re-greasing BPW LL Self-steering Axles

- O Park the vehicle on level ground and chock the wheels.
- O Clean the kingpin areas and the grease nipples and check grease nipples for tightness and serviceability.
- O Check the relevant wear indicators for remaining life of thrust washers see Tech Topics 04/2015 for more information.
- O Jack up the self steering axle until the wheels are off the ground to unload the kingpins.
- Release the steer axle lock.
- O Apply the correct BPW ECO Plus Grease to the relevant grease nipple at the bottom – ● – of the steering knuckle.
- While applying the grease rotate the kingpins so that the grease is spread correctly all around the wear areas inside the steering knuckle.
- Keep applying grease until the new grease appears in the gap between the undulating thrust washers
   1 this will push out the old grease.
- Continue to apply new grease until all traces of old grease are pushed out of the gap between the undulating washers – §
- Wipe away excess grease so that the new grease forms a seal around the undulating washers - •
- O Apply the correct BPW ECO Plus Grease to the relevant grease nipple at the top − ② − of the steering knuckle.

- While applying the grease rotate the kingpins so that the grease is spread correctly all around the wear areas inside the steering knuckle.
- Keep applying grease until the new grease appears around the kingpin in the gap between the steering knuckle - 3 - and the axle housing - 4 - this will push out the old grease.
- O Continue to apply new grease until all traces of old grease are pushed out of the gap between the steering knuckle − ⑤ − and the axle housing − ⑥
- Wipe away excess grease so that the new grease forms a seal around the gap between the steering knuckle − 3 − and the axle housing − 4

Replace grease nipple caps.
